- "The Big 3"
- Lamps
- > Batteries
- > Consumer Electronics

Then the rest:

- Pesticides
- Oil-based Finishes
- Mercury containing devices

Universal Waste Handler -Issues Found During Inspections

- Using Proper Containers
- Labeling / Marking
- Accumulation Time
- Treatment / Disposal
- Record-keeping



Proper Containers



Proper Containers

- Must be structurally sound
- Adequate to prevent breakage (UW lamps)
- Must remain closed while in storage
- Compatible with the contents of the UW
- Must not show evidence of leakage, spillage
- Containers that do not meet the requirement must be overpacked (UW pesticides)

BROKEN BULBS

Must be collected and handled as hazardous waste. Store in a separate secure container.



Keep lid secure at all times.

Consumer Electronics Waste

Stored in outside shed. Brought to county site once per year or as required. Must have a label with accum, start date, Labels located at the collection space in the shed. Please see facility maintenance for removal and labeling.

Electrical and electronic waste equipment includes - cell phones, printers, desktop and laptop computers, computer monitors, and microwave ovens.

Record "Accum Start" at start of use. Top cover must be on at all times. Container must be removed from facility 1 year from Accum. Start date.

Labeling Universal Wastes



Labeling / Marking

- Universal Wastes must be labeled / marked either by container or individually
- Simplest way to comply is using a piece of paper taped to a container. However, a purchased pre-printed label is acceptable
- Label must be clear, legible, and easily visible

Labeling / Marking

- Acceptable wording is:
- ➤ "Universal Waste Lamps", "Used Lamps", or "Waste Lamps"
- "Universal Waste Battery(ies)", "Used Battery(ies)", or "Waste Battery(ies)"
- > "Universal Waste Consumer Electronics"
- > "Universal Waste Pesticides"
- > "Universal Waste Oil-Based Finishes"
- "Universal Waste Mercury Containing Devices"



Accumulation Time

- Universal waste may be accumulated for no longer than one year from the date the universal waste is generated
- Simplest way to comply is by marking the container/equipment with the accumulation start date (most accurate)
- Maintain manifests, bill of ladings, or invoices, showing proof of shipment offsite

Universal 01/01/2010 Waste

Treatment / Disposal

- Handlers are prohibited from diluting or treating universal waste (i.e. crushing lamps)

• Handlers are prohibited from disposing of universal waste

Record-keeping

- Only Large Quantity Handlers are required to keep records of shipments of universal waste
- Acceptable records include logs, invoices, manifests, bill of ladings etc.
- Records must show the name & address of the destination facility; the quantities & types of waste sent; and the date of shipment
- Records must be kept for three years
- Record-keeping optional for Small Quantity Handlers but recommended
