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Registration

All generators of Regulated Medical Waste (RMW) in New Jersey are required to register with the Department and pay a fee based upon the quantity of waste generated per calendar year.

- A new registration is required if your facility;
 - Is initially registering.
 - Moves to another address.
 - Changes Tax Identification # (FEIN) due to a change in business operation/ownership
- An updated registration is required if your facility changes;
 - Mailing address.
 - Fees/Billing contact information.
 - Business Name (with no change in FEIN)
 - Generation Category (*see below*)

Fees

- Initial fee when registered
- Annual issued in July for registration cycle of July 22 through July 21
- Fee assessed based upon quantity **expected** to be generated during registration cycle

Generator Category	Pounds of Regulated Medical Waste Generated Annually	Fee
1	>50 Pounds	\$85
2	50 – 200 Pounds	\$255
3	201 – 300 Pounds	\$500
4	301 – 1,000 Pounds	\$1,000
5	>1,000 Pounds	\$3,500

Annual Report

- Report required for Generator Category 3, 4 & 5
- Generators operating as Category 1 or 2 are supposed to certify annually they are not subject to reporting
- Report/Certification is done using NJDEP online service

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
