September 30, 2007	<p>Site Remediation Program eliminates use of Method 418.1 (all matrices)</p>
January 1, 2008	<p>Water Programs require use of methods as given in MUR</p> <p>MUR revisions fully adopted in NJ-ELCP</p> <p>MUR deleted parameters/method references included in NJ-NELAP to satisfy needs of other state Accrediting Bodies, but listed as “Not Eligible to Report NJ Data” on NJ Annual Certified Parameter Lists</p>
