EPA Voluntary Programs

To receive stewardship recognition for an **EPA VOLUNTARY PROGRAM**, a site must participate in any EPA sponsored voluntary program. Documentation confirming registration and participation in at least one EPA Environmental Stewardship or EPA Partnership Program is required to receive credit.



Stewardship through participation in EPA VOLUNTARY PROGRAMS

*Sites should be able to clearly identify the formal EPA program they participate in.

- \Rightarrow Sites should be able to describe their participation in the program.
- * A sites must be an EPA registered partner to receive recognition.
