



# ATTENTION ANGLERS

## 2002 NJ MINIMUM SIZE, POSSESSION LIMITS & SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS

Fish are measured from tip of snout to tip of tail (**EXCEPT Black Sea Bass**)  
 Cleaning or filleting of fish with a minimum size limit while at sea is prohibited.



**Weakfish**  
 14 fish at 14 inches




**Hard Clam**  
 Recreational Limit - 150 clams  
 NO SUNDAY HARVEST



**Striped Bass or Hybrid Striped Bass**  
 1 fish at 28"  
 1 fish at 24" but less than 28"

Del. River & tribs. (Rt. 1 bridge); Trenton to Salem River & tribs.  
 Open Mar. 1 - Mar. 31 & June 1 - Dec. 31  
 Atlantic Ocean: 0-3 miles from shore - no closed season  
 Greater than 3 miles from shore - closed  
 All other marine waters, open Mar. 1 - Dec. 31




**Summer Flounder (Fluke)**  
 8 fish at 16 1/2 inches  
 Open Season: May 18 - Sept. 24




**Tautog**  
 14 inches  
 Open Seasons:  
 10 fish Oct. 10 - May 31  
 1 fish June 1 - Oct. 9

 SHORTNOSE STURGEON

 WHITE SHARK




**Winter Flounder**

 25 fish at 11 1/2 inches




**Bluefish**

 peeler or shedder - 3 inches  
 soft - 3 1/2 inches  
 hard - 4 1/2 inches  
 Recreational limit: one bushel
