

# **AMERICAN SHAD**

Alosa sapidissima

## **Description:**

- ♦ black spot just behind the gill opening, usually followed by a row of 2 or more smaller, less distinct dark spots
- ♦ upper jaw extends to rear margin of eye
- ♦ silver body with dark green to blue back
- ♦ cheek deeper than it is long

#### **Size**:


- ♦ up to 30 inches
- ♦ largest member of the herring family

## Range:

♦ Atlantic coast from Sand Hill River, Labrador, Canada to St. John's River, Florida

### **Facts:**

- ♦ the Delaware River is the principal spawning area in NJ
- ♦ important food source for people along the river
- **♦** travel in large schools
- **♦** important prey for birds and larger fish
