Pseudopleuronectes americanus

Description:

- **♦** straight lateral line
- **♦** small mouth
- \otimes scaled area between eyes
- **♦** right eye flounder

Size:


♦ up to 25 inches

Range:

♦ Labrador, Canada to Georgia

Facts:

- ♦ winter inshore in bays and estuaries
- ♦ spawn in winter and spring in shallow inshore waters
- **a** during a single spawning period, females release a total of 500,000-1.5 million eggs over 40 separate releases
- ♦ move to deeper waters during summer months
- **♦** important food fish
- ♦ lifespan is 15-20 years
