Meeting called to order by K. Simonetti at 10:20AM

- A motion was made by D. Nickerson, and seconded by G. Smisko, to approve the amended January 27, 2016 minutes. A vote was taken with all in favor.
- K. Moser gave an update on WRAC terms. No opposing nominations were received and all representatives will be renewing their positions. H. Freeman expressed interest in the vacant reptile position and will be sending her resume to P. Nelson.
- A motion was made by Dr. E. Miller, seconded by T. Leaver, to nominate D. Nickerson as the committee chair to be effective July 27, 2016. A vote was taken with most in favor, and abstention from D. Nickerson.
- K. Moser gave an update on the proposed regulations to combine captive game and exotic and nongame species. It is generally an 18-month process. Division personnel have begun having meetings with lawyers, and stakeholder meetings are expected to begin soon. An email will be sent out regarding stakeholder meetings.
- Concerns were discussed regarding ethics and conduct for rehabilitators. Suggestion was made by D. Nickerson to write a Code of Conduct into the WRAC bylaws. Dr. E. Miller offered to send ENSAC's Code of Conduct as a template.
- Discussion ensued on bear rehabilitation.
- A motion to adjourn was made by K. Simonetti, seconded by Dr. E. Miller. A vote was taken with all in favor.
