Dear New Jersey Black Sea Bass Permit Holder: New Jersey Black Sea Bass Dealer:

Please be advised, that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25:18.12(h)8iii.(7), the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, with the approval of the Marine Fisheries Council has modified the **Season 3** directed black sea bass trip limits.

Trip limit modifications are in response to a surplus of underutilized quota encountered during the Directed Season 1.

Effective Sunday, May 17, 2020, the Season 3 directed black sea bass trip limits will be modified as follows:

Season 3 (May-June): 800-pound trip limit with a maximum of 5 days per week or

1,000-pound trip limit with a maximum of 4 days per week or

2,000-pound trip limit with a maximum of 2 days per week

The modified Season 3 directed trip limits will be in effect until such time as the directed Season quota is projected to be taken.
