

# Atlantic Needlefish

### Strongylura marina



### **Description:**

- ♦ long, narrow body
- green above with silvery sides
- adults have a thin bluish stripe along each side
- dorsal and anal fins are set towards back of body just before tail
- pectoral fins are small and set high on the sides
- lower jaw extends beyond upper
- elongated jaws with sharp teeth

#### Size:

• up to 24 inches

#### Range:

♦ Maine and northern Gulf of Mexico to Brazil

#### **Facts:**

- found in coastal waters, bays and estuaries
- generally nocturnal and actively feed at night
- feed mostly on shrimp and small fish, like peanut bunker and silversides
- spends a lot of time near the surface
- jump out of water chasing small fish
- drawn to light, therefore they congregate near piers and bridges
- spawn late spring to summer
- females release thread-like eggs that sink and stick to each other
