

Comely Shiner

Notropis amoenus



Description:

- slender compressed body
- slightly slanted mouth
- smaller eye
- pointed snout
- dorsal fin origin behind pelvic fin origin
- silvery fish with narrow dusky stripe along back and silvery dusky stripe along sides
- 11 anal rays

Size:

up to 4 inches

Range:

- Atlantic Slope drainages from Hudson River,
 NY to Cape Fear, NC; one report each from
- Seneca Lake, NY and Yadkin River system, NC


Facts:

- found in flowing pools and runs of creeks and medium to large rivers
- prefers sand and gravel bottoms
- almost identical to emerald shiner but has smaller eye and less slanted mouth
- very little has been reported therefore not much is known of these fish
