

# Redfin Pickerel

## Esox americanus americanus



# **Description:**

- dark olive green to dark brown
- black bar below eye slanted towards rear
- dorsal fin orange to red, leading to the name 'redfin'
- amber to white belly
- ♦ 15-36 dark green to brown wavy bars on side of adult
- fully scaled cheek and opercle
- ♦ 11-13 branchiostegal rays
- ♦ 17-21 dorsal rays
- ♦ 16-20 anal rays

#### Size:

up to 15 inches

#### Range:

♦ Atlantic slope drainages to southern Georgia

#### **Facts:**

- likes weedy areas of sluggish streams, lakes and ponds
- tolerant of low oxygen conditions
- can live in brackish water
- spawn in spring, when water reaches 50° F
- no nest or parental care
