Leiostomus xanthurus



Description:

- forked caudal fin (tail)
- dark blotch on shoulder
- bluish gray back; silvery to white belly
- pale yellow fins
- elevated back; deep belly
- ♦ 12-15 diagonal stripes over back
- no chin barbels

Size:

• up to 14 inches

Range:

♦ Massachusetts to northern Mexico

Facts:

- spawn offshore in deep water of outer continental shelf
- can spawn in near shore waters and estuaries
- depending on location, spawning takes place from October to March
- live up to 5 years
- often congregate over oyster beds
- opportunistic bottom feeders primarily eating worms, small crustaceans, and mollusks
