

Windowpane Flounder

Scophthalmus aquosus



Description:

- ♦ thin bodied
- ♦ left eyed flatfish
- left side olive green to light brown
- many dark brown spots on body and fins
- ♦ bottom side is colorless
- lack lateral line strongly arched toward front
- first dorsal ray is branched, the tips of the rays are not attached to the membrane and form a fringed crest

Size:

♦ up to 18 inches

Range:

♦ Gulf of St. Lawrence to northern Florida

Facts:

- likes sandy bottoms
- occurs in bays and estuaries
- ♦ both eyes on left side of body, mouth points to the left
- less muscle then most other flatfish
- mouth is toothless
