### **Description:**

- straight lateral line
- small mouth
- scaled area between eyes
- right eye flounder

#### Size:

up to 25 inches

#### Range:

• Labrador, Canada to Georgia


#### **Facts**:

- winter inshore in bays and estuaries
- spawn in winter and spring in shallow inshore waters
- during a single spawning period, females release a total of 500,000-1.5 million eggs over 40 separate releases
- move to deeper waters during summer months
- important food fish
- lifespan is 15-20 years
