The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) invites the communities of Jersey City, Hoboken and Weehawken to a Design Zone Workshop on the Rebuild by Design – Hudson River Project. All are welcome! This workshop will discuss the alignment in the North end of the project area from the border of Weehawken, through Harborside Park, to the termination on Washington St south of 14th St.

WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

The Rebuild by Design - Hudson River Project is a comprehensive urban floodwater management strategy **to reduce the flood risk from storm surge** and rainfall flood events to flood prone areas within the Project Area, which comprises the entire City of Hoboken, and adjacent areas of Weehawken and Jersey City. The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded \$230 million to the State of New Jersey for the Project, which includes the design and environmental impact analysis of the overall comprehensive master plan of the entire project (including the Resist and Delay, Store, Discharge components) and funding for the construction of the Resist components (coastal storm surge projects).

WHAT'S HAPPENING NEXT?

During this phase of work, the Resist components (flood control structures to resist storm surge) will be designed. NJDEP is engaging the public and stakeholders in the Project Area to participate in the design of the Resist components (see map below).

At this meeting you will:

- Be updated on community input received at the first public meeting that took place May 9th;
- Provide input on the character of design interventions along the Resist alignment within Design Zones 2 & 3;
- Provide input on the program of design interventions along the Resist alignment within Design Zones 2 & 3.
