### PROJECT NAME AND DESCRIPTION:

**RP01-101 DENNIS CREEK HEADWATER RESTORATION AND REFORESTATION, WOODBINE,  
CAPE MAY COUNTY  
319(H) - \$57,480**

This project was implemented at the Woodbine Developmental Center property through an area farmed (corn) by the Department of Corrections. The project involved restoring approximately 800 linear feet of the riparian corridor of the headwater area of Dennis Creek by creating a 150 foot wide buffer (75 feet on either side of the stream) through what was previously planted in corn. This buffer project, completed in 2003, has become well established providing stormwater treatment for runoff from the surrounding farming activities.
