

## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that the County of Mercer and the New Jersey Turnpike Authority have filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to dispose of a portion of certain parklands located at Block 2732, Lots 3 and 4 in the Township of Hamilton, totaling approximately 1.454 acres, in connection with the New Jersey Turnpike 6-9 Widening Program, which consists of approximately 35 miles of road widening and associated interchange improvements from the vicinity of Interchange 6, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County (Milepost 48) to Interchange 9 in East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County (Milepost 83). As compensation for the proposed disposal of portions of Block 2732, Lots 3 and 4 in the Township of Hamilton, Mercer County will receive eighteen thousand and six hundred dollars (\$18,600.00) which will be utilized as contribution toward the purchase of approximately nine (9) acres of land at Block 30, Lot 12 in East Windsor, to be operated jointly as public parkland under a management agreement between the County of Mercer and the Township of East Windsor.
