TAKE NOTICE that Hudson County has filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to permanently dispose of 2.56 acres and temporarily divert 0.5 acres of Hudson County Park at Laurel Hill (Block 1, Lot 3 in the Town of Secaucus), in connection with the construction and operation of the Portal Bridge Capacity Enhancement Project. The purpose of the project is to replace the nearly 100-year old Portal Bridge in order to eliminate capacity constraints on the Northeast Corridor and reduce conflicts with maritime traffic.
