

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that the City of Atlantic City has filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to divert approximately 0.13 acres of Public Bathing Beach ("Parkland"), known as Lot 126 in Block 1 on the official Atlantic City Tax Map, and located at the eastern terminus of Tennessee Avenue. The parkland diversion will allow the installation of an underground electric cable to be directionally drilled below the Parkland surface to serve a proposed off-shore wind farm facility. Compensation will be provided as a monetary contribution to the "Boardwalk and Beach Open Space Fund", created by the City of Atlantic City and Casino Reinvestment Development Authority ("CRDA"). The amount of the compensation will equal ten (10) times the appraised value of the proposed easement.
