**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Turnpike Authority has filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to acquire ownership of a portion of certain parklands from the Township of Bordentown. The parkland to be transferred, located at Block 92, Lots 20 and 21, Block 92.01, Lot 1 and Block 93, Lots 3 and 10 in the Township of Bordentown, consists of approximately 5.44 acres in fee and 4.65 acres in easement (the "Parkland").

The Parkland is needed in connection with the New Jersey Turnpike 6-9 Widening Program, which consists of approximately 35 miles of road widening and associated interchange improvements from the vicinity of Interchange 6, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County (Milepost 48) to Interchange 9 in East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County (Milepost 83).
