**Program Description:** The Bureau of Sustainability encourages New Jersey businesses to adopt practices that prevent pollution, enhance the community, and support the economy. The Bureau accomplishes this goal through a disciplined understanding of pollution prevention principles that can be applied to improve environmental quality across a variety of businesses. Technical assistance is given to those businesses who need environmental compliance assistance and to those businesses that wish to achieve their sustainability goals. Additionally, the Bureau fosters innovative pollution prevention strategies by hosting networking events like the *Sustainable Speaker Series*, and the *WasteWise Network*. Businesses that adopt quantifiable sustainable actions can be recognized through the Stewardship Program or through the Sustainable Business Registry. The Bureau also provides many educational resources that promote the benefits of taking active steps toward sustainability.

**Internship Hours Per Week:** Fully in person 35 hours per week.

**Hourly Rate:** Sliding Scale based on Education Level (\$16-\$21 Per Hour).

**Project Description:** Prepare case studies of businesses that have successfully implemented sustainable actions, which will include an analysis of the cost savings to the business and the positive impacts on the community.

**Specific to the Position:** Seeking Individuals with graphic design, writing skills and/or research skills.

Preferred/Required Area of Study: Environmental, Sustainability, or Business studies.
