Interns will assist in tracking municipal concerns, researching issues, and developing outreach efforts associated with a wide variety of environmental issues.

Estimated Project Duration and Suggested Weekly Work Schedule: Fall, Spring, and Summer sessions - 2 to 3 days a week with flexible hours.

Internship Learning Objectives / Marketable Skills: Interns will gain insight into DEP's regulatory responsibilities (e.g. permitting, brownfields redevelopment, open space preservation, etc.), will be able to analyze and research constituent concerns, and will be able to develop outreach strategies for addressing intergovernmental issues.

Description of DEP Program Area/Work Unit Offering the Internship:

The Office of Local Government Assistance is the liaison to Local government provides assistance with environmental questions and concerns for the benefit of New Jersey's 565 municipalities and 21 counties. This office also works directly with other groups that coordinate programs throughout the year that deal with such issues as housing, redevelopment, permitting, etc. The office also works with outside entities (e.g. New Jersey State League of Municipalities) to address issues of concern to the department.
