

Hunting permitted within Forest Boundary during all regular and permit hunting seasons except within areas designated as:

 **No Hunting Zone**

Consult the NJ Fish & Wildlife Digest for zone details.

**PLEASE:**

- Licensed, registered, and insured vehicles are permitted on roads.
- Remove portable tree stands at the end of the hunting season.
- Adhere to all N.J. State Park Service Administrative Codes including N.J.A.C. 7:2.
- Adhere to N.J. Fish & Wildlife Rules and Regulations:

**NOT PERMITTED:**

- Driving vehicles off-road.
- Use of ATVs.
- Alcoholic beverages.
- Smoking or vaping (except in personal vehicles).
- Permanent tree stands.
- Hunting within 450ft (firearm) or 150ft (bow) of a building.
- Firing across a roadway or trail.
- Area closed a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise.

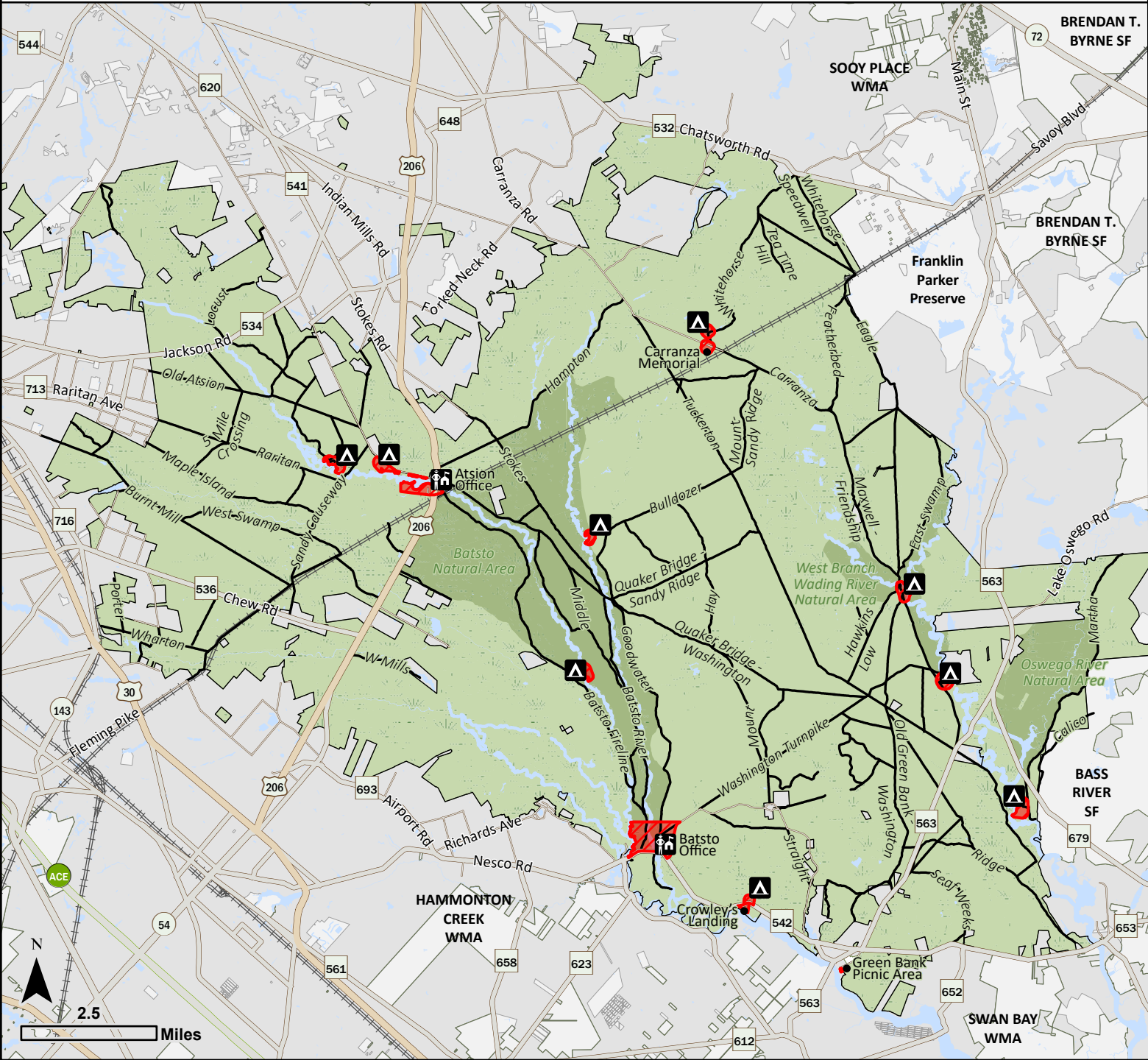

# Wharton State Forest Hunting Map











**All motorized vehicles** operating on unimproved roads must be street legal, registered, insured and operated by a licensed driver. Vehicles and operators are subject to the motor vehicle laws of the State of New Jersey, N.J.S.A. 39:1-1, et seq.

**Roads in Wharton State Forest** traverse sandy and frequently unimproved conditions. Visitors are encouraged to approach roads with caution and check-in with the Forest office for current conditions.

**Temporary road closures** may occur at any time due to weather, maintenance or State Park Service operational needs. Updates will be posted to [dep.nj.gov/wharton/](https://dep.nj.gov/wharton/).

**What is hunting access?** Solid black lines identify access for those actively engaged in hunting. Hunters may access these areas with a legal motorized vehicle during an active hunting season with a valid New Jersey hunting license per Fish and Wildlife regulations. Hunters should be prepared for difficult conditions.
