NOT PERMITTED:

- · Driving vehicles off-road.
- · Use of ATVs.
- · Alcoholic beverages.
- · Smoking or vaping (except in personal vehicles).
- · Permanent tree stands.
- Hunting within 450ft (firearm) or 150ft (bow) of a building.
- · Firing across a roadway or trail.
- · Area closed a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise.


