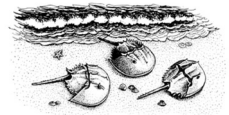


# Fall and Winter Nature Programs at Liberty State Park

## **Low Tide Beach Walk \* Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and Saturday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 \* 10 – 11:30AM**

Join us for a stroll along the beach to see what the tide has brought ashore. Please dress to be outdoors and wear old shoes that can get wet and muddy. *You will need your own vehicle to get to the study site.*



## **Fall Bird Walk \* Sunday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 \* 10AM – Noon**

Located along the Atlantic Flyway, Liberty State Park is home to over 250 different species of birds. Join us as we explore varied habitats and learn to identify some of our resident and migratory birdlife. *Please dress to be outside and bring binoculars if you have them. Binoculars are available to borrow.*



## **Fall Leaves Walk \* Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 \* 10AM – 11:30AM**

As the weather starts to cool and the leaves begin to change, it's a perfect time to come explore the beauty of fall at Liberty State Park. Join our Park Naturalist on this guided walk and learn how to identify some of our trees by their fall colors.

## **Winter Evergreen Trees \* Saturday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 \* 10AM – 11:30AM**

Come on out to Liberty State Park and join us for an evergreen investigation. We will learn how to identify different types of evergreens and about the valuable role these trees play in nature.

## **Winter Waterfowl Walk \* Sunday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Sunday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, & Saturday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018**
