WHEREAS, The State Department of Environmental Protection has found through investigations made by its representatives that Philip Carey Corporation in the City of Linden, County of Union and State of New Jersey, is discharging industrial waste and other polluting matter into Peach Orchard Brook, a tributary of the Arthur Kill, being waters of this State, thereby causing or threatening injury to the inhabitants of this State either in their health, comfort or property, in violation of R.S. 58:12-2; and

WHEREAS, The State Department of Environmental Protection has found through investigations made by its representatives that Philip Carey Corporation in the City of Linden, County of Union of the State of New Jersey, is discharging harmful, deleterious and polluting matter including industrial wastewaters from a sewer or drain into Peach Orchard Brook, a tributary of the Arthur Kill, being waters of this State, without approval of the State Department of Environmental Protection as required by R.S. 58:12-3; and

WHEREAS, The State Department of Environmental Protection, in consideration of the aforesaid findings, is of the opinion that in order for the industrial wastewaters to be properly, adequately and sufficiently treated and/or otherwise disposed of, industrial wastewater treatment and/or disposal facilities must be provided in a manner approved by the State Department of Environmental Protection; therefore

1. Complaints of odors from the West Brook in the area of South Wood Avenue and Clinton Street.
- 2. Complaint that Smith and Kanzler Corporation, 1414 East Linden Avenue, Linden, New Jersey is permitting a white milky substance to discharge into Peach Orchard Brook.
3. Complaint that Alpha Industrial Services, Incorporated is polluting King's Creek.

On July 12, 1966, representatives from the Department of Health, Stream Pollution Control Program investigated the above stream pollution complaints.

The odors emanating from West Brook were due to a storm drain pipe discharging sewage at the rate of approximately 250,000 gallons per day. This pipe is located under the Winans Avenue bridge, Southeast of Twelfth Street. Mr. Charles Saunders from the Linden-Roselle Sewerage Authority, was notified about the discharge from Winans Avenue. There was also a discharge of water and/or anti freeze from the West Lake Auto Radiator, 350 Elizabeth Avenue, possibly from the repairing of old radiators. The discharge was approximately fifteen feet Northwest of a protruding black pipe on the bank of the West Brook.

Mr. Andrew Johnson, Manager and Mr. George Broom, Chief Chemist, both of Smith and Kanzler, 1414 East Linden Avenue assured us that the white-milky discharge which they called sodium silicate, will be discharged into their lagoon. They estimated this discharge to be ten gallons per day. The lagoon was said to contain asbestos fiber and water from paper processes.

Mr. Robert Jones from Alpha Industrial Services, Incorporated, 1600 West Elizabeth Avenue, Linden, was sent a letter by our Department recommending steps in preventing pollution by their firm. A copy of this letter is attached to this memo.


