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DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION *Continued Violation -*

Contractor was directed to begin work on proposed sewer line designed to carry effluent from Wolcott Chem. Co. to local sanitary sewer on Harrison Ave. Work began with construction of manhole located at entrance to sanitary sewer and sewer line then proceeding east approximately 50-75' where another manhole was placed for cleanout purposes. Sewer line then turns north and proceeds thru Wolcott property and presently is beyond East Railroad track where it was tunneled. Work is progressing well despite difficult working condition hampered by underground water. Pumps are necessary for pumping water from trench excavation.

Will report further as work progresses.
