**Take notice** that the State of New Jersey and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) have entered into an Agreement for the State to regulate source, certain special nuclear, and byproduct material, which Agreement is effective September 30, 2009. Accordingly, the new rules and amendments to N.J.A.C. 7:28, Radiation Protection Programs, that were adopted September 15, 2008 are operative as of September 30, 2009. Under the rules, the Department of Environmental Protection will regulate source, certain special nuclear and byproduct material, in accordance with the State's Agreement with the NRC.
