SRP as a Whole: Greatly Reduced Backlog of Sites

Pre-SRRA case count (May 2009) ≈ 20,000

• SRP current case count = 13,739

Total Cases Closed = 19,746

Goal achieved for 2014
 Close Out More Cases than We Get In

Priority Initiative:Focus Resources on IECs

- Staff freed up to support IEC identification and response
- IEC staff bolstered to address 513 IECs currently identified (297 using public funds, 216 by responsible parties)
- Receptor Survey Team / Receptor Evaluation Requirements
- IECs now identified sooner and more proactively
 - Last 5 Years = 271 IECs identified
 - Prior 5 years = 135 IECs identified
- USIs find the source of the IEC



Regulatory Update

- Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board Rules Proposed December 2014.
- New Chapter 26F: Heating Oil Tank System Remediation Rules – Anticipated Proposal is Fall 2015
- Amendments to ARRCS, Tech Regs, NJPDES and UST rules related to new Chapter 26F – Anticipated Proposal is Fall 2015
- Remediation Standards Readopt w/o change April 2015;
 Amendments in Stakeholder Process; Proposal Jan 2016

 - RI Report (NEW)
 - Remaining Remedial Phase Reports coming!
- 20 Technical Guidance Documents finalized
