# **SRP as a Whole: Greatly Reduced Backlog of Sites**

- Pre-SRRA case count (May 2009)  $\approx$  20,000
- SRP current case count = 13,739
- Total Cases Closed = 19,746
- Goal achieved for 2014  
Close Out More Cases than We Get In

(as of March 31, 2015)





# **LSRP Program: Increasing Rate of Cleanup and Readying Sites for Redevelopment**

- RAOs 2011 = 762
- RAOs 2014 = 1,742
- RAOs to date = 5,825
  
- Cases Closed 2011 = 433
- Cases Closed 2014 = 1,295
- Cases Closed to Date = 3,854

(as of March 31, 2014)





# **Priority Initiative:** **Focus Resources on IECs**

- Staff freed up to support IEC identification and response
- IEC staff bolstered to address 513 IECs currently identified (297 using public funds, 216 by responsible parties)
- Receptor Survey Team / Receptor Evaluation Requirements
- IECs now identified sooner and more proactively
  - Last 5 Years = 271 IECs identified
  - Prior 5 years = 135 IECs identified
- USIs find the source of the IEC

(as of March 31, 2015)





# Regulatory Update

- Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board Rules – Proposed December 2014.
- New Chapter 26F: Heating Oil Tank System Remediation Rules – Anticipated Proposal is Fall 2015
- Amendments to ARRCs, Tech Regs, NJPDES and UST rules related to new Chapter 26F – Anticipated Proposal is Fall 2015
- Remediation Standards – Readopt w/o change April 2015; Amendments in Stakeholder Process; Proposal Jan 2016





# Upcoming Initiatives and Ongoing Stakeholder Process

- DEP Online
  - Fees, LSRP Retention/Release
  - RI Report (NEW)
  - Remaining Remedial Phase Reports – coming!
- 20 Technical Guidance Documents finalized
  - 7 more in development
