The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) completed review of the Revised Vapor Intrusion Remedial Investigation Report dated December 17, 2010. The Regulatory Agencies have determined that the Revised Vapor Intrusion Remedial Investigation Report is in compliance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E, the Administrative Consent Order dated September 15, 1988 and other applicable requirements. However, the conclusions made pertaining to typical indoor air background levels and their relation to concentrations found during the VI investigation are not relevant to the direction of this investigation, based on the levels of site-related compounds in the ground water and sub-slab soil gas. The Regulatory Agencies hereby approve the Revised Vapor Intrusion Remedial Investigation Report, effective the date of this letter.
