Community Notice

The New Jersey Department of Environmental of Protection (NJDEP) will start remediation of the Harrison Avenue Landfill in December 2007 at the above referenced site. The interim remedial measure will consist of excavation and off-site disposal of approximately 14,000 cubic yards of contaminated material that resulted from disposal of industrial waste in a localized area in the interior of the landfill. The material is contaminated with volatile organic contaminants, including but not limited to chlorobenzene and benzene, and is acting as a continued source of ground water contamination and localized soil vapor contamination.

The NJDEP will implement continuous dust and odor suppression measures during construction activities. Air-monitoring stations will be established to measure dust particulates and continuous air monitoring will be performed for vapors to ensure these measures are effective. The hours of operation will be 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

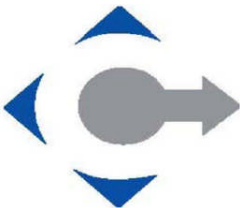
