Purpose of the Public Meetings:

The Wilson Avenue School is prepared to open for the 2010/2011 school year. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) and the Department of Health and Senior Services will conduct two meetings with the community to present the results of their investigation efforts conducted in and around the school. Attendance at both meetings is not necessary, as the same information will be presented at both meetings.

Important Information:

- Installation of a new sump pump system that includes vapor extraction is complete. Vapors from the ground water beneath the school are being extracted, treated, and safely discharged through a carbon filter unit from the roof of the school.
- Testing conducted throughout the school shows that <u>all levels</u> are <u>below</u> action levels. Another round of sampling will be conducted in the winter to confirm the levels remain below action levels.
- The source of the ground water contamination remains unknown. Additional work will be conducted on the outside of the school to treat the ground water. The existing contamination will be reduced over time with these actions.
