



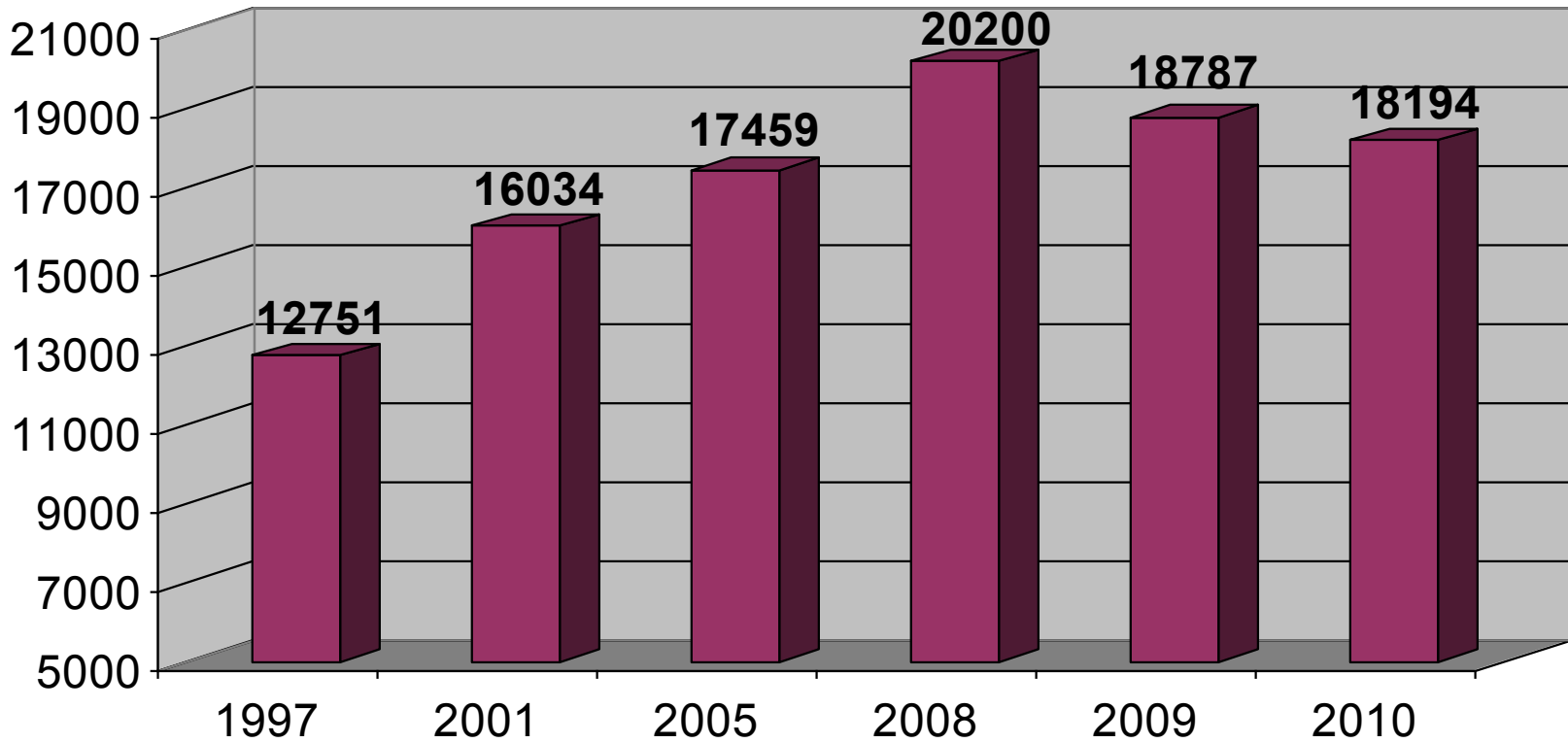

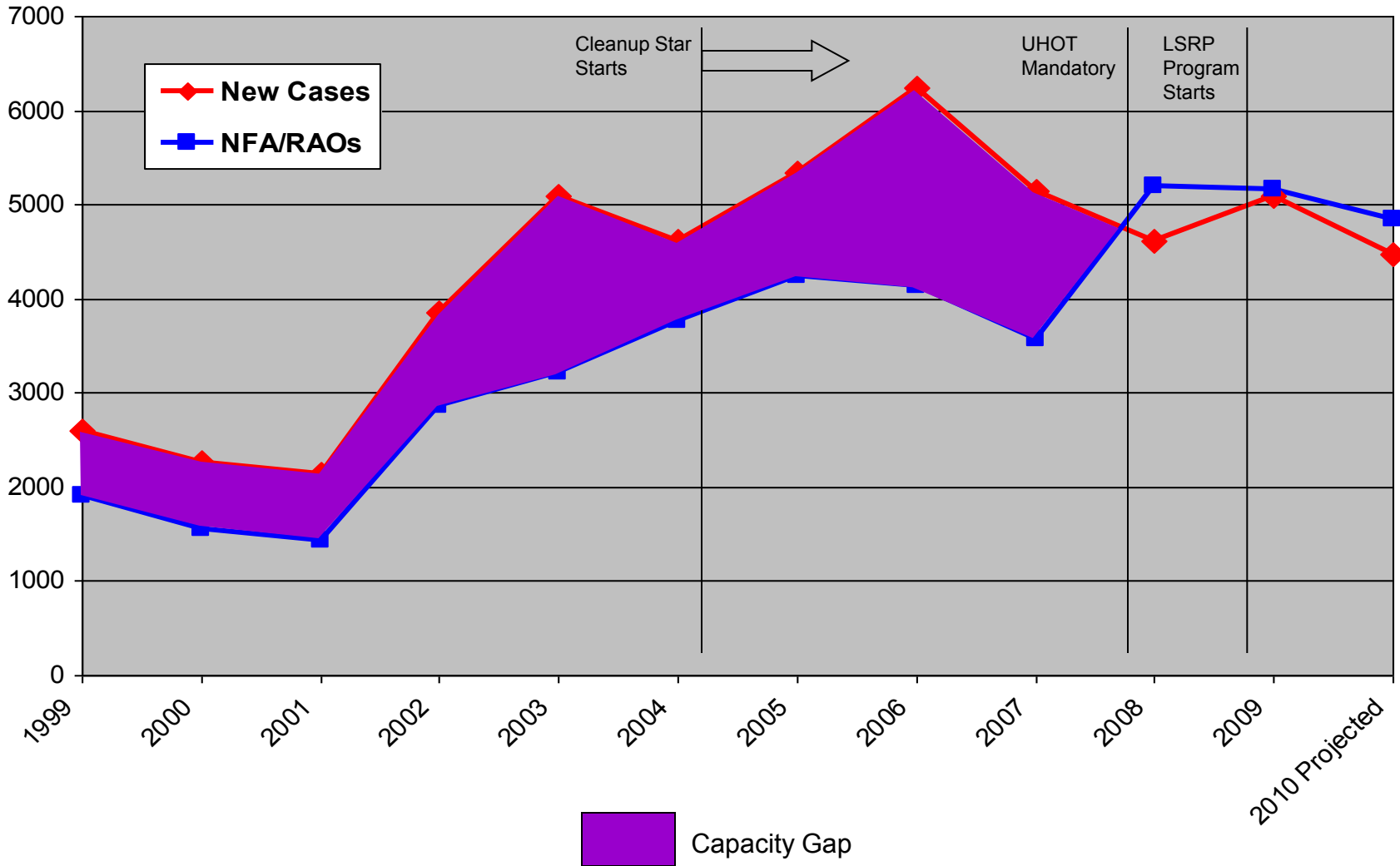
Active Cases Peak in 2008: Shows the Need for Reform

Chart 1 - Case Count



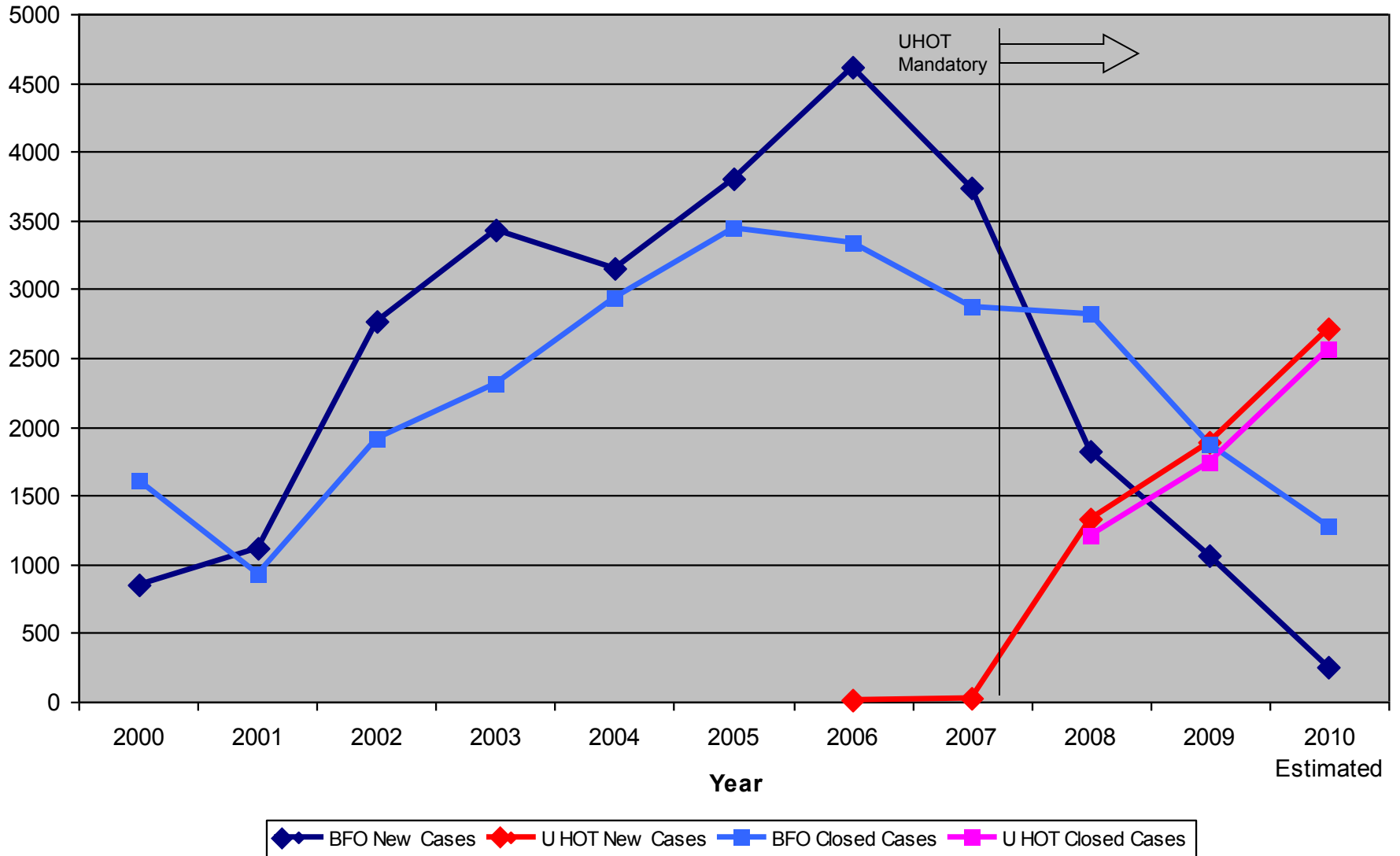
New Cases Decline While Completions Rise Closing Capacity Gap

Chart 2 – Number of New Cases Versus NFA/RAOs



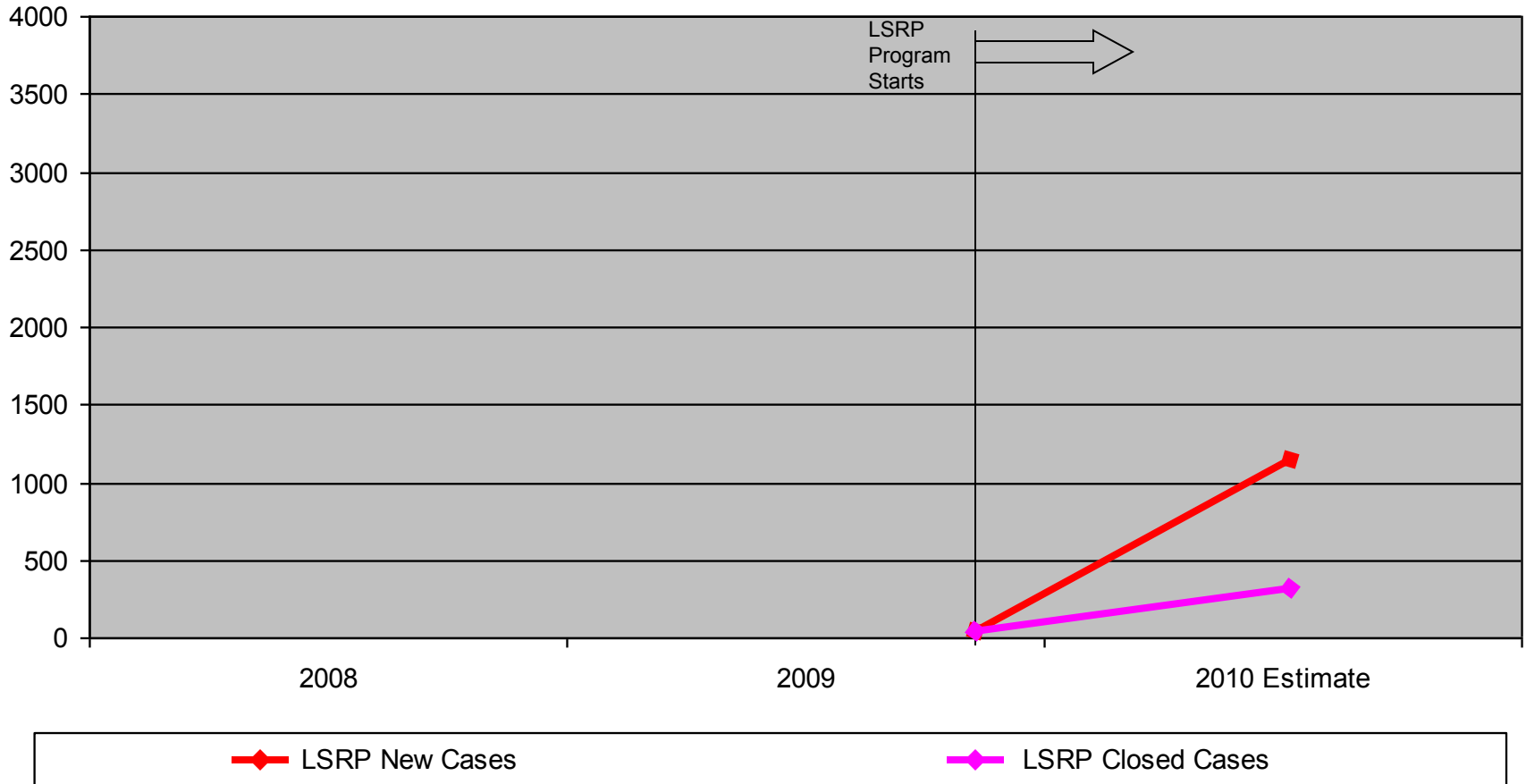
UHOT has Direct Impact on Caseload and Case Closeout

Chart 3 - BFO vs. U HOT New and Closed Case Comparison



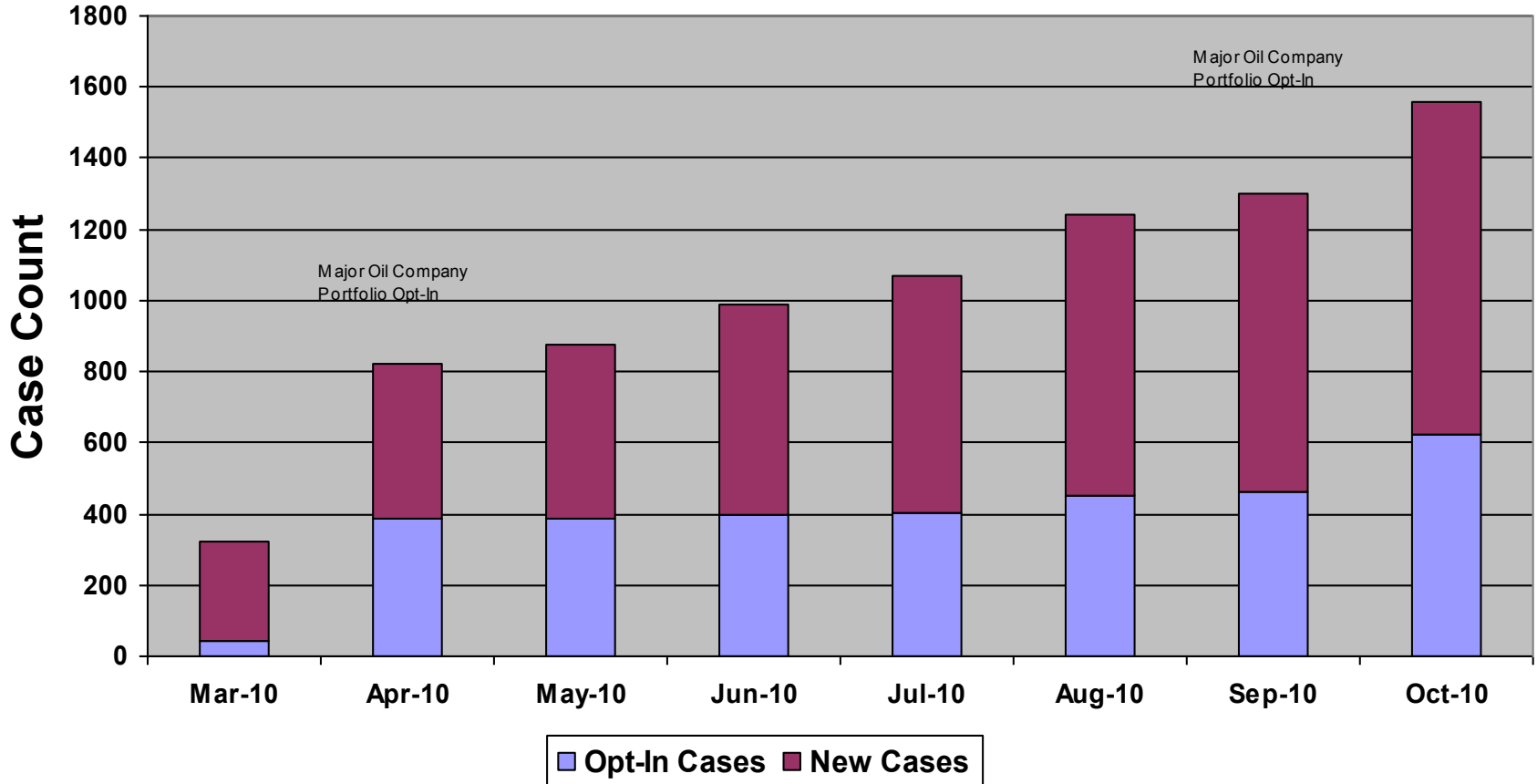
LSRP has Similar Impact on Caseload and Case Closeout

Chart 4 –LSRP New and Closed Cases



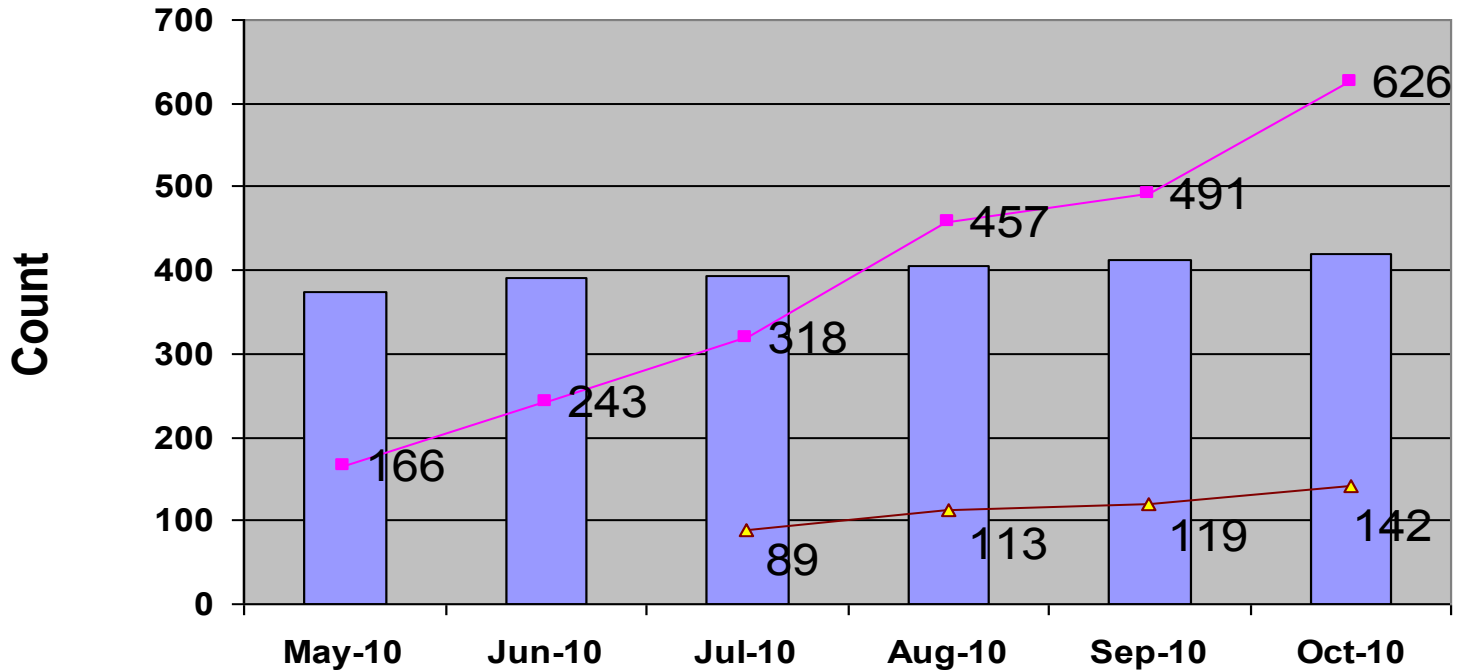
Increasing Trend for Cases in LSRP Program

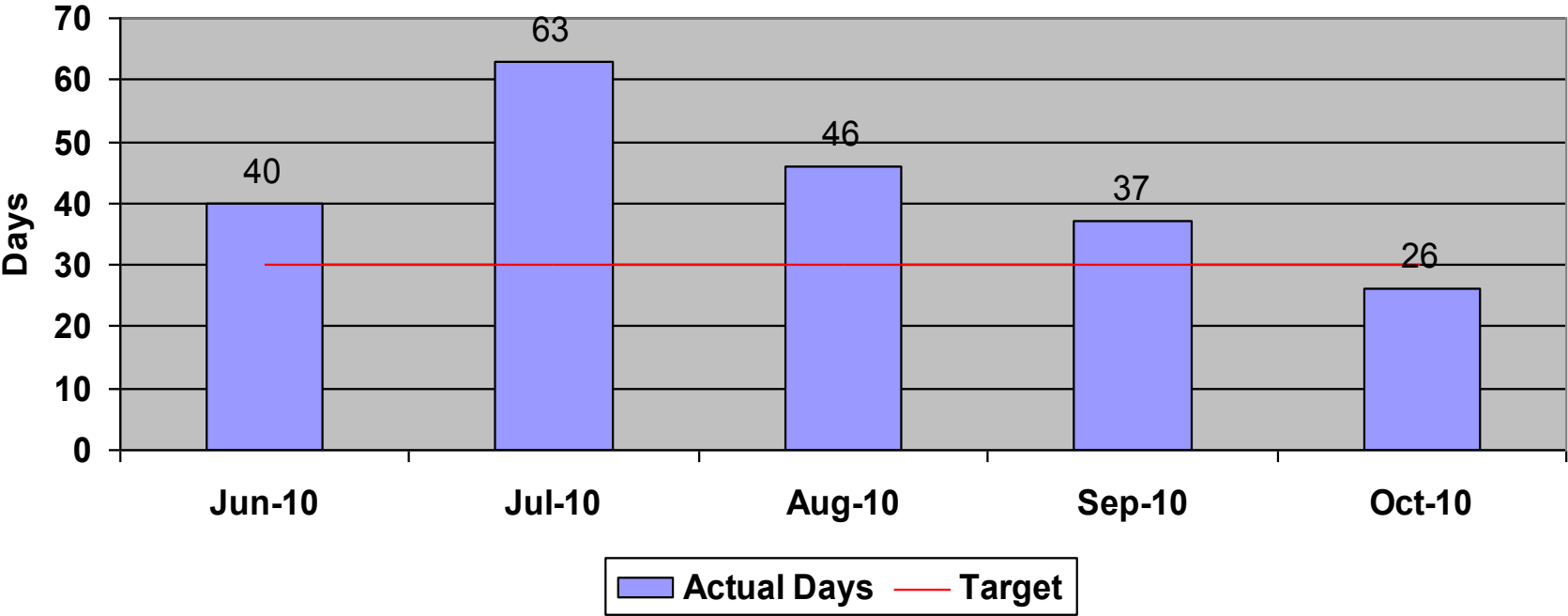
