Documentation of Independent Professional Judgement

What it is:

- Documentation of the factors considered during decision making
- How those factors influenced decisions or actions
- A written discussion including all information identified and evaluated

What it is not:

A written statement that professional judgement was utilized without any supporting documentation

Reminders

- Permit writer, inspector, and the reviewer have no previous knowledge of subject site
- Permit writer, inspector, and the reviewer do not have copies of previous submittals - unless submitted through the portal
- Permit writer, inspector, and the reviewer do not know what is going on at neighboring properties

Supporting Independent Professional Judgement

Submissions should include:

- Clear table of contents
- Detailed information
- Multiple lines of evidence
- Copies of previous submittals or sections of submittals if relevant to submittal's conclusion
