CECs and Timeframes

- Guidance to be issued shortly.
- Since the phase status and timeframes vary based on site-specific factors, a range of options will be available to either request extensions, merge new incidents into existing case activities, or create new case activities with a separate set of timeframes.
- If a new case activity is created with a new set of timeframes, it can't be merged back.
- If an RAO-E is required (i.e., ISRA Case), an RAO-E can't be issued until both/all case activities are ready for RAOs.
- The Department encourages LSRPs to issue RAO-As for the original case activity in order to meet original timeframes and reduce annual remediation fees (if applicable).
