

Financial Obligation Summary Report

This report enables the requestor to determine if there are any outstanding oversight cost bills for a given site that have not been paid. The requestor can also determine if oversight costs have been charged to the site but have not yet been included in a bill. The name of the party the Department has on record as responsible for paying the oversight bill can be found here as well as information about financial assurance for the site and oversight payment history. Among other reasons, this report can be used to assure that all oversight costs have been paid before certifying requests to proceed with remediation without the Department's oversight.

#### GENERAL (5)

This category has been designed to identify all the sites in your neighborhood. The General Reports have been broken down into two sub-categories, the Sites & Cases sub-category and the Administrative / Oversight sub-category.

Attachments Available in Site Remediation

This reports enables the user to search for electronic documents available in the Site Remediation and Waste Management Program using the Program Interest Number. If available, the user will be able to download the electronic documents. While all documents are not currently available, over 300,000 can be downloaded. An OPRA request should still be conducted for additional records.

Sites with a Immediate Environmental Concern

This report enables the requestor to receive a list of all cases that have been given the status of "Immediate Environmental Concern" (IEC), means a condition at a contaminated site where any of the following conditions are found: contamination in a well used for potable purposes at concentrations at or above the Class II ground water remediation standards; or contamination in indoor air at a level greater than any vapor intrusion indoor air rapid action level; or contamination that exceeds the Department's acute human health exposure levels in surface soil such that dermal contact, ingestion, or inhalation of the contamination could result in an acute human health exposure, as further described in the Department's IEC Guidance; or contamination in an occupied or confined space producing a toxic or harmful atmosphere resulting in an unacceptable human health exposure, or producing an oxygen deficient atmosphere, or resulting in demonstrated physical damage to essential underground services.

> Sites with a Immediate Environmental Concern by Municipality

This report enables the requestor to receive a list of all cases that have been given the status of "Immediate Environmental Concern" (IEC), means a condition at a contaminated site where any of the following conditions are found: contamination in a well used for potable purposes at concentrations at or above the Class II ground water remediation standards; or contamination in indoor air at a level greater than any vapor intrusion indoor air rapid action level; or contamination that exceeds the Department's acute human health exposure levels in surface soil such that dermal contact, ingestion, or inhalation of the contamination could result in an acute human health exposure, as further described in the Department's IEC Guidance; or contamination in an occupied or confined space producing a toxic or harmful atmosphere resulting in an unacceptable human health exposure, or producing an oxygen deficient atmosphere, or resulting in demonstrated physical damage to essential underground services.

The Known and Suspected Sites by County

This report enables the requestor to view a list of both known and suspected sites within a specified county.

XY Well Permit Search

This report retrieves all approved/accepted well documents received by the NJDEP that have been electronically data managed. Cancelled permits where no well was drilled are not displayed. Each row displays information for a permit, record, or decommissioning, updated 8/16/2018

#### INSTITUTIONAL CONTROLS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS (8)


This category contains reports on institutional controls including biennial certification reports. An institutional control is a mechanism used to limit human activities at or near a contaminated site. Institutional controls may include, without limitation, structure, land, and natural resource use restrictions, well restriction areas, classification exception areas, deed notices, and declarations of environmental restrictions. Refer to the Site Remediation Technical Requirements N.J.A.C. 7:26E -1.8 and the Ground Water Quality Standards N.J.A.C. 7:9C-1.6 for more information.

This report displays Biennial Certification listings for CEAs and Deed Notices.

Cases Requiring Remedial Action Permits

This selection enables the requestor to view a real time list of all active sites in SRWMP which previously received a No Further Action letter with an institutional control and are required to obtain a Remedial





#### Introduction to DEP DocMiner

The **HighVIEW DocMiner System Version 2.1** grants access to the NJDEP's online library of Regulatory Documents dating back from the 1950's to present day.

The DocMiner System assists users in finding these documents by providing search capabilities on Sites, Projects, and other Program Identifiers. Not only will DocMiner help locate and organize the documents to the user, it also contains functionality that helps the user better understand the vast information that can be returned from the library without having to manually read each individual document. Once documents are discovered, users can view, export, and print the documents regardless of their original file format (PDF, XLS, DOC, ZIP, Email, Etc.).


If you know the specific name or DEP identifier, go to the Search Option section and select the type of search you would like to perform and enter the desired value into the window provided. DocMiner will display the supporting documentation available from the library for review.


If you do not know the specific DEP identifier information, there are two search options available to find this information (DEP DataMiner and Map Display). Once you have the DEP identifying information you may use it to find the publicly available DEP records that are stored electronically in DEP's record management system.


