Frank Pinto provided an overview of the status of the Permanent Licensing Exam <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidate Bulletin to be issued in February 2012 which will provide information on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Advisory to LSRPs and non-LSRPs ii. Categories of Questions on the exam iii. Instructions on how to apply for exam iv. ADA accommodations v. 1st 4 exam dates/locations (subject to change) • No prep classes anticipated by vendor administering exam. • Application for exam will be posted on DEP website. Two forms: one form for Temporary LSRPs and one form for non LSRPs. Approval and authorization from DEP is required in order to take exam • 1st exam to be given in May 2012 with 3 more exam dates within 9 months of first exam. • Suspend temporary exam process in April. No temporary licenses will be issued after 1st exam is given. • If fail Exam, can be taken again (up to 3 times total) in order to pass. Temporary license still valid during this time frame. • If fail the exam 3 times then can no longer be a practicing LSRP, however all work done under temporary license remains valid. They would have to wait 1 year to apply to take the exam again.
