## **Requirements:**

- 1. All written public education (PE) materials must be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (BSDW) for review and approval prior to distribution/issuance (40 C.F.R. 141.85(a)(1)).
