NOTICE ABOUT UPDATED MONITORING SCHEDULES FOR 1, 2, 3 TCP, EDB, DBCP

Please be advised that the Bureau of Safe Drinking Water is in the process of updating monitoring schedules for 1,2,3-trichloropropane (1,2,3-TCP), ethylene dibromide (EDB), and 1,2-dibromo-3-chloropropane (DBCP). Any point of entry that submitted four (4) consecutive quarters of non-detectable results for all 3 analytes will receive a monitoring reduction. Please note that for all schedules, EDB and DBCP, which are federally regulated analytes, are being combined into a group schedule called "SOC2". 1,2,3-TCP, which is state regulated, will remain as an individual schedule. Your updated monitoring schedules will be available on Drinking Water Watch and you will be receiving a letter with your new requirements within the next few weeks.
