## **Summary:**

The East Branch Rahway River received a "very poor" rating in 2013, and has the lowest (8.33) HIBI score in the network. This site was dominated by pollution tolerant fishes. This site is located in an urban park setting and had no overhead tree canopy cover, severe channelization and had several stormwater outfalls discharging into the stream. Habitat restoration was completed at this site in 2011 to redesign the banks and develop a riparian buffer along the stream.
