## ADDITIONAL TOXICS

- Hydrogen Sulfide
  - Landfills
  - Odor



- N-propyl Bromide
  - Dry Cleaning
- Sulfuryl Fluoride
  - TAP in MD
  - Significant Use





# CLARIFY FUMIGATION APPLICABILITY

- Significant Risks at Low Concentrations
- Fumigants are used to control (kill) invasive species
- Close Proximity to Communities
- Ground Level Emissions (Frequently no stack)





### **EMISSION STATEMENT**

- Based on Relative Risk
- What is Actually Released?
  - We don't know
  - We do know what is in permit



Has not been evaluated since 2003
