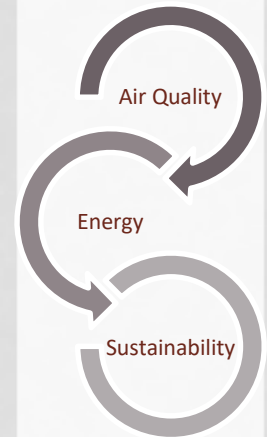

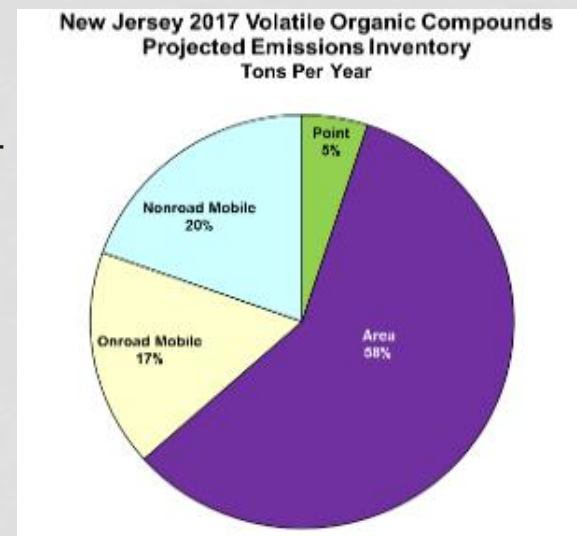

- Penalty Provisions N.J.A.C. 7:27A-3.10

WHY THESE RULES

- NJ Northern Non-attainment Area bumped up to a “serious” classification for ozone
- Consumer Products are the largest source of VOCs largest contributor
- Major Sources are no longer the largest contributor to ozone precursor
- Cost effective measures
- Model Rules in place
