



REVISION TO THE ATLANTIC COUNTY WATER QUALITY  
MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on OCT 16 1990, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Atlantic County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision allows the Atlantic County Department of Regional Planning and Development a time extension in their submission of a Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) for Atlantic County. Under N.J.A.C. 7:15, the Atlantic County Department of Regional Planning and Development is required to submit a WMP on or before October 2, 1990. This revision extends this period until April 2, 1991.
