

REVISION TO THE ATLANTIC COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT  
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **SEP 23 1993**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Atlantic County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision acknowledges the existence of Weymouth Township Elementary School at the time of the Weymouth Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) adoption on August 4, 1989. This school was inadvertently not included within the Weymouth Township WMP. The Weymouth Township Elementary School is under a State mandate to increase their building space from the current 27,000 sq. ft. to a total of 41,000 sq. ft. The expansion of the school facility is not intended to accommodate additional students. The design capacity of the existing school septic system is 3,500 gallons per day for a functional school capacity of 277 students. There is no expansion being considered for the septic system currently located at the school. The Pinelands Commission supports the expansion of the building proposal.
