

AMENDMENT TO THE CAPE MAY COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **DEC 03 1993**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Cape May County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. The amendment updates the Lower Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) in regard to **Cold Spring Village**. The sewer service area to the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority (LTMUA) Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) as delineated in the Lower Township WMP will be expanded to include the existing, historic Cold Spring Village in Lower Township. The discharge to ground water from the existing on-site ground water disposal system serving this Village will be eliminated upon connection of the Village to the LTMUA STP.
