

REVISION TO THE CAPE MAY COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **OCT 10 1996**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Cape May County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Dennis Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) with regard to the Dennis Township Elementary School located in Dennis Township, Cape May County. The WMP is updated to identify the property as Block 70, Lots 16, 17, 18, and 19, and Block 69, Lot 11.01. The WMP is also updated to identify the design capacity of the existing on-site ground water disposal system serving the school as 12,000 gallons per day consistent with Treatment Works Approval Permit No. S-89-1525-4.

The current student population is approximately 845. The Dennis Township Board of Education proposes to construct six additional classrooms and an expansion to the existing shop area. The additional classrooms and shop expansion are proposed to accommodate a student population of approximately 916. Based on actual water use and wastewater discharge data, the existing on-site ground water disposal system is sized to accommodate the total flow from the increased population. Therefore, no expansion to the on-site ground water disposal system serving the school is proposed or required.
