**REVISION TO THE CAPE MAY COUNTY WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT  
PLAN**

**TAKE NOTICE** that on **AUG 19 2004**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58-11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Cape May County Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision includes the Cape May County Zoo Fairgrounds, a fast food concession stand, an employee building, and a picnic park. This facility is located in Middle Township, Cape May County at Route 9 and County Route 585, and consists of Block 99.02, Lots 42, 45.058, 45.06, 46.01, and 46.02. This revision expands sewer service area to an additional 91.4 acres due to the failure of the existing subsurface units. The total sewage flow for the additional area to be included in the sewer service area amounts to approximately 28,366 gallons per day (GPD). The treatment facility is the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority's Seven Mile/Middle Township Treatment Facility, which has a design flow of 7.67 million GPD. The receiving water of the discharge is the Atlantic Ocean. This revision is being adopted in accordance with Administrative Consent Order (ACO), Docket Number CPM-L-226-00, between the Department, Cape May County, and the Township of Middle. This ACO specifically provides for extension of sewer service area to the Cape May County Park and Zoo conditioned on the Department's receipt of certification by the County Health Officer that the systems are failing, cannot be corrected, and present public health risk. The County of Cape May provided the required documentation on August 5, 2004.
