

REVISION TO THE CAPE MAY COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **JUN - 1 2009**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Cape May County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision also modifies the Cape May County Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The revision addresses the existing facilities and units in a campground identified in the WMP. The Frontier Campground located in Upper Township on Block 548/Lot 20, utilizes on-site Sanitary Subsurface Sewage Disposal System General Permit (T-1) permitted septic systems that operate under New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permit number NJG0084972 as identified in the WMP. The Campground includes 187 campsites, 144 of which are sewered and the following wastewater generating structures: a general store, a bath house with showers, a three bedroom existing residence, and a laundry/bath house building. This revision is being adopted in accordance with N.J.A.C.7:15-3.5(b)1, which allows revisions in order to correct, clarify, or update erroneous, unclear, or outdated statements in an areawide WQMP.
